### Book Arts Basics

A great introduction to book arts! Sign your students up for a pair of classes to round out their book arts experience at a discounted rate. Choose a book structure and either a papermaking or printing activity from the options below.

### Papermaking and Printing (choose one)

■ K-2<sup>nd</sup> ■ 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> ■ 6<sup>th</sup>- 8<sup>th</sup> grade



#### Intro to Papermaking

Students learn the process of turning plants into paper. Using Western papermaking tools, each student uses a mould and deckle to pull wet paper pulp to make two sheets of paper.



#### Class Printed Poster – Letterforms or Symbols

A great introduction to the history of written communication and printing. In this collaborative project, each student designs one symbol or letter to be included on a class poster.



### Bookmaking (choose one)



#### 3D Single Sheet Book

Stretch your children's idea of what a book can be. One sheet of paper with a little folding and cutting is transformed into a frog, fish, castle, bird or butterfly.



#### M-Fold Accordion Book with Cover

This simple accordion book gives students an introduction to bookmaking and large pages gives students ample room to create stories and images after class.

### 8 Section Accordion Book

The versatile accordion book is created by folding a long sheet of paper to create individual pages. This structure allows the viewer to read a page at a time or to view the entire book at a glance.



### Hidden Page Book

This accordion book's unique structure allows pages to be split apart to uncover hidden sections. An ideal format for students to express different viewpoints or story ideas.



### Flag Book

Using an accordion spine, this structure has small alternating pages that wave and open to reveal a hidden illustration or message. It is a fun book for poems, riddles, and question/answer formats.



### Petal Fold Book

This sculptural book has petal-shaped pages inspired by origami.



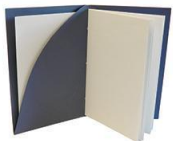
### Landscape Tunnel Book

Participants will be encouraged to think creatively as they explore depth perception with text and image.



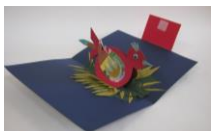
### Stab Binding – 2 sizes

Students will learn an eastern bookbinding technique with this simple yet elegant design. Available in 2 sizes this is a binding technique students can easily apply to make additional books for future school projects.



### Sewn Pamphlet with Pockets

Not only does this simple western bound book offer plenty of writing space, it also has a front and back pocket students can use to collect notes or items for inspiration!



### Tower Pop-Up

Starting with a soft cover base with Velcro closure, students create a tower pop-up that transforms into a bird, ship or dragon when the book is opened.
