### Project Workshop Options 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Grades



#### 8 Section Accordion Book

The versatile accordion book is created by folding a long sheet of paper to create individual pages. This structure allows the viewer to read a page at a time or to view the entire book at a glance.

#### Hidden Page Book

This accordion book's unique structure allows pages to be split apart to uncover hidden sections. An ideal format for students to express different viewpoints or story ideas.

#### Meander Tunnel

This book project incorporates both a tunnel and an accordion all from a single sheet of paper! Students will be encouraged to think creatively as learn about layout planning and design perspectives.

#### Flag Book

Using an accordion spine, this structure has small alternating pages that wave and open to reveal a hidden illustration or message. It is a fun book for poems, riddles, and question/answer formats.

Stretch your children's idea of what a book can be. One sheet of paper with a little folding and cutting is transformed into a frog, fish, castle, bird or butterfly.

This sculptural book has petal-shaped pages inspired by origami.

#### Portrait Pop-Up

The landscape pop-up book uses a variety of pop-up techniques to create a landscape scene that is enclosed with a wrap-around cover. Fun to make, this book structure is also a dynamic way to present school reports.

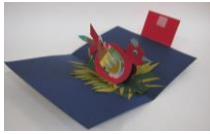

### Hard Cover 4 Section Pop-Up Book

Explore the third dimension with a variety of pop-up techniques to create one long or 4 short landscape scenes. This book is a great way to introduce both eastern and western bookmaking techniques.

### Tower Pop-Up

Starting with a soft cover base with Velcro closure, students create a tower pop-up that transforms into a bird, ship or dragon when the book is opened.

Participants will be encouraged to think creatively as they explore depth perception with text and image. Landscape and portrait versions available.

Students will learn an eastern bookbinding technique with this simple yet elegant design. Available in 2 sizes this is a binding technique students can easily apply to make additional books for future school projects.

### Japanese Folder with Sewn Journal Insert

This Japanese folder is a single piece of decorative paper folded several times to create multiple pockets. Students will then add sewn pages to create a softcover book.

This classic book is a great introduction to western bookbinding techniques. Students leave this workshop with a book that is perfect for future class notes or sketches.

Two books in one! There are three different formats to choose from. The traditional dos-a-dos opens in two opposite directions; each is sewn with Western pamphlet pages. Not only does this offer plenty of writing space, it provides a format to write from different perspectives; one voice from the first side and a second from the opposite side.

### Faux Limp Vellum with Tacket Binding

This lovely book is reminiscent of books from the Middle Ages. It's great as a personal journal; sturdy and flexible with a faux leather strap closure.

### Screw Post Journal/Sketchbook – 2 sizes

The versatile hinged screw-post binding is useful for gathering single sheets to use as a portfolio, journal, or to publish student writing. The removable screw-post allows for addition, subtraction and reordering of pages in the classroom. Two sizes are available.

### Papermaking – 2 levels

Embossing, handprints, shaped papers, double sided papers, and decorative inclusions allow students to explore a new papermaking technique!

### **Paper Marbling: Suminigashi**

Suminagashi marbling is a Japanese technique in which students create concentric rings of colors with a brush, other tools, or even a fan!

A great introduction to the history of written communication and printing. In this collaborative project, each student designs one symbol or letter to be included on a class poster.

Through a process of paper cutting and collaged paper, each student will create their own multi-tone print design. Students will print multiple copies of their individual design on a Vandercook printing press.
