

MCBA's Open Studio programming provides artists with regular, low-cost access to studios and equipment outside of workshops. Studio Fellows are available to answer questions or help with equipment, but participants must have adequate training to work independently in the area(s) they wish to utilize.

## **ARTIST COLLECTIVE**

Studio access + more for working artists.

MCBA provides ongoing studio access through its Artist Collective, comprised of dedicated artists working in papermaking, paper marbling, letterpress printing, screen printing, bookbinding, and related arts. Artist Collective Members receive 24-hour access to the MCBA studios and library, preferred press access on Open Studio nights, the opportunity to show work in the annual Artist Collective exhibition in MCBA's Main Gallery, a 50% discount on MCBA workshops (by registering two weeks in advance of the start date), and the opportunity to participate in Art-Share sessions.

**Dues:** \$165/month (minimum six month commitment) MCBA offers a discounted rate of \$115/month for degree-seeking college students and recent graduates for up to two years after graduation.
